ADACHI INTERNATIONAL ACADEMY

This Academy is a Pilot Educational Project sponsored by a group of Catholic

religious organizations that run universities, Middle and High Schools in Tokyo.

The newly established Academy is located a 10minute walk from Umeţima Station

(Adachi-ku) See the map attached to the Program.

Objectives and Vision

The Academy is oriented to provide basic educational tools to children (6 to 15 year

old) born to foreign parents that face difficulties in following computatory education as well as

to those children that dropped from school but desire to continue their studies.

The Academy also provides Japanese language training and cultural lessons to

adults of foreign nationalities, as well as lessons in English conversation for Japanese

nationals.

Methodology

The Academy offers an educational approach, based on Christian values, stressing

the building of human personality and human respect within an atmosphere of community

building. It is tutorial and emphasizes a "person to person" approach, so that children

acquire confidence and enjoy learning. It is not directly oriented to prepare students for

school entrance examinations.

Educational Content

The following subjects are envisioned:

(1) For Children: Arithmetic and Mathematics / Japanese and Kanji lessons / English

lessons / Computer education (Office Word and Office Excel) / Exposure programs /

Summer intensive courses

(2) For Adults: Japanese lessons (Kana and Kanji drills) / English conversation (for

Japanese) / Computer education (Office Word and Office Excel, Power Point) /

Japanese culture and important info to live in Japan

From Tuesday to Sunday (Monday is a rest day)

Daily schedule: AM: 10:00 ~ 12:30 PM: 2:00 ~ 8:30

Monthly Fee

In order to cover administration costs and the use of the facilities a minimum monthly fee of:

¥3,000 per child (¥4,500 in case of two brothers and ¥6,000 for three)

¥1,000 per adult, per subject (for instance, ¥1,000 for Japanese class and ¥1,000 for computer education)
