About

David directs COPENHAGEN at the Crucible Theatre, Sheffield in spring 2012, as part of their MICHAEL FRAYN SEASON, starring Henry Goodman and Geoffrey Streatfeild. After this, he goes to Tokyo to direct ENRON. In 2011, he revived JOURNEY'S END which did 2 national tours and returned to the West End. He directed the first major revival of John Guare's SIX DEGREES OF SEPARATION at the Old Vic, starring Lesley Manville and Anthony Head, in 2010.

On Broadway, in 2009, he directed THE PHILANTHROPIST by Christopher Hampton starring Matthew Broderick and THE AMERICAN PLAN by Richard Greenberg starring Mercedes Ruehl. That year, he also directed A MIDSUMMER NIGHT'S DREAM at the Stratford Shakespeare Festival in Canada. In the summer of 2011, David returned to the Stratford Shakespeare Festival to direct THE MISANTHROPE.
